The audience is typically 200-300 coker people—last year 50% were refiners.

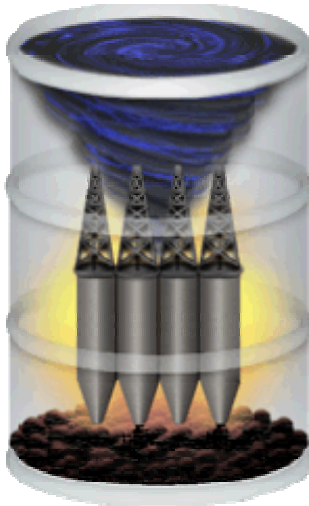
Additional presentations and sharings can be 5, 10 or 20 minutes followed by Q&A.
