We are expecting 150 attendees.

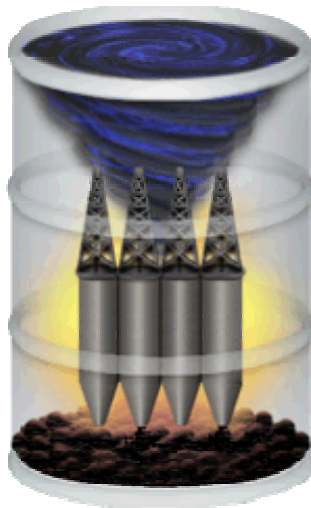
Additional presentations and sharings can be 5, 10 or 20 minutes followed by Q&A.
